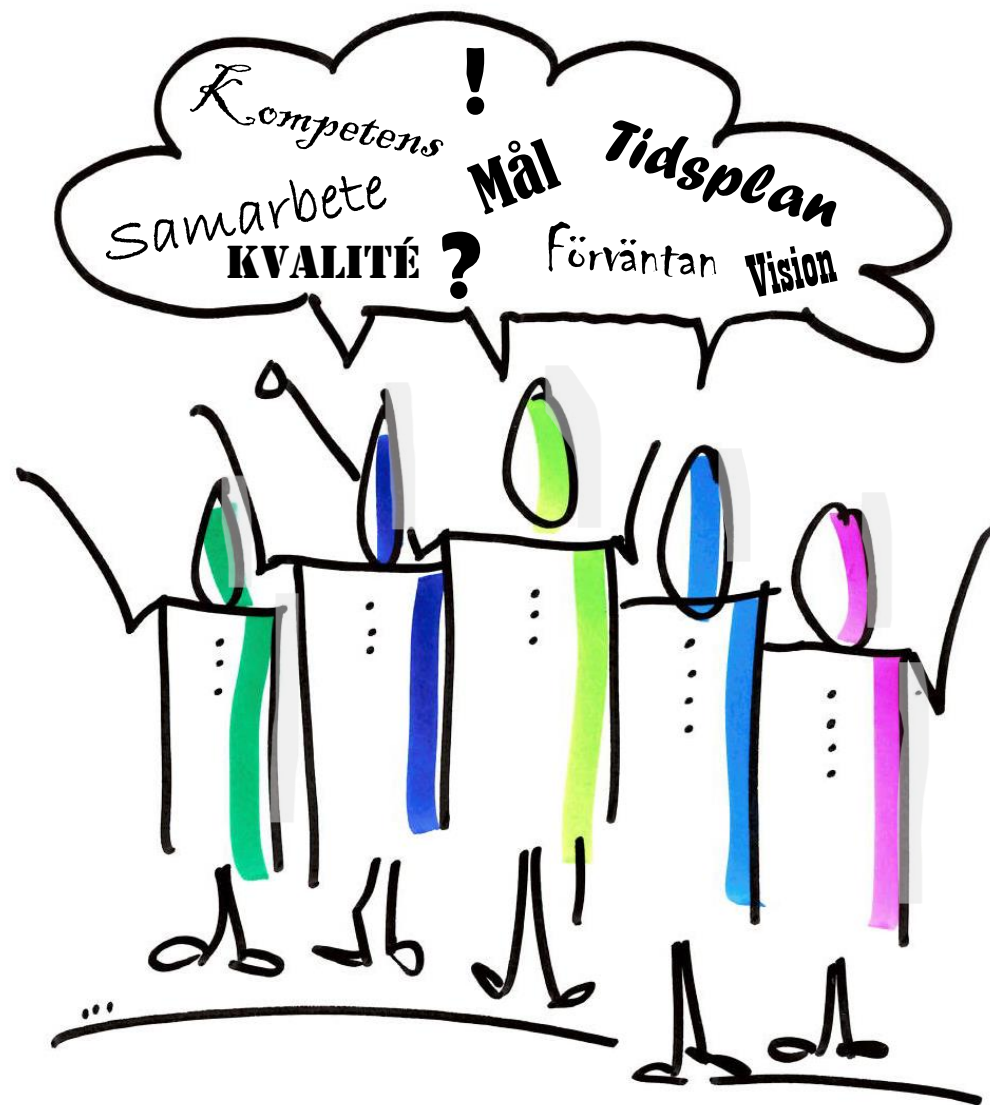
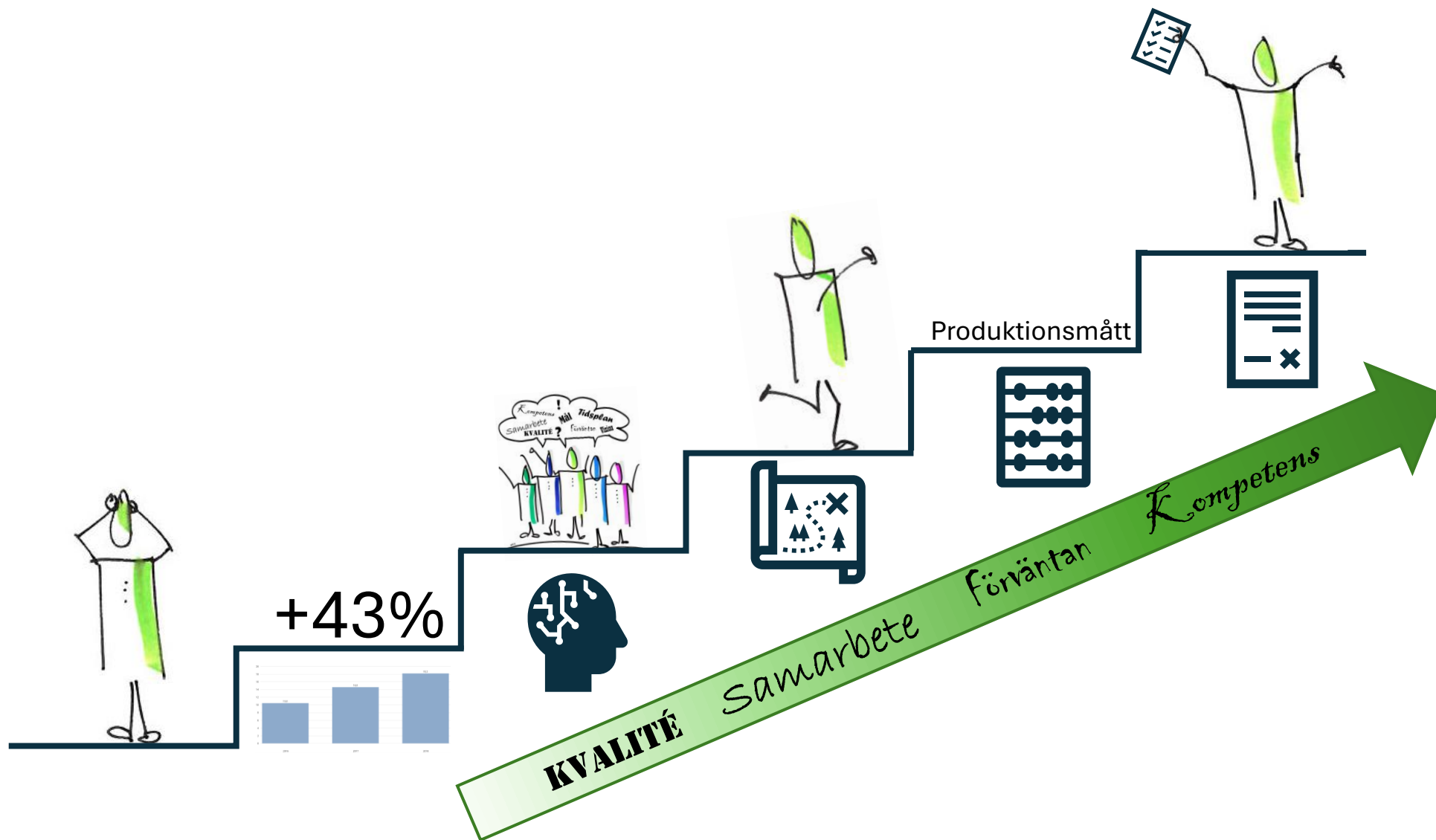


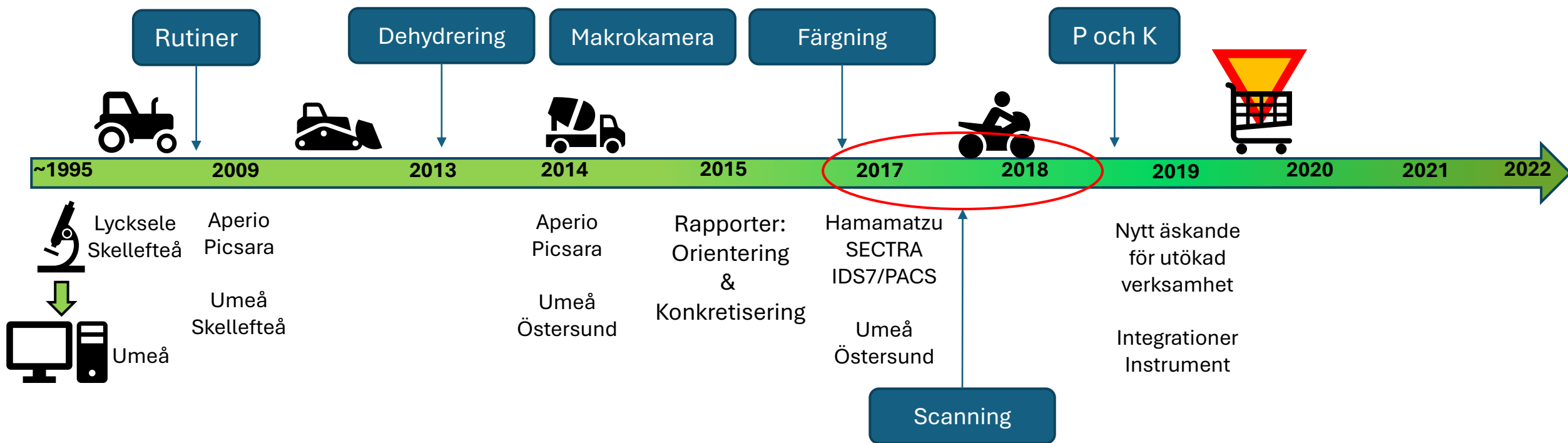

Some crypts show signs of architectural distortion and increased cellularity, which are characteristic of inflammatory bowel disease. The overall appearance is one of chronic inflammation with cryptitis and crypt abscesses.

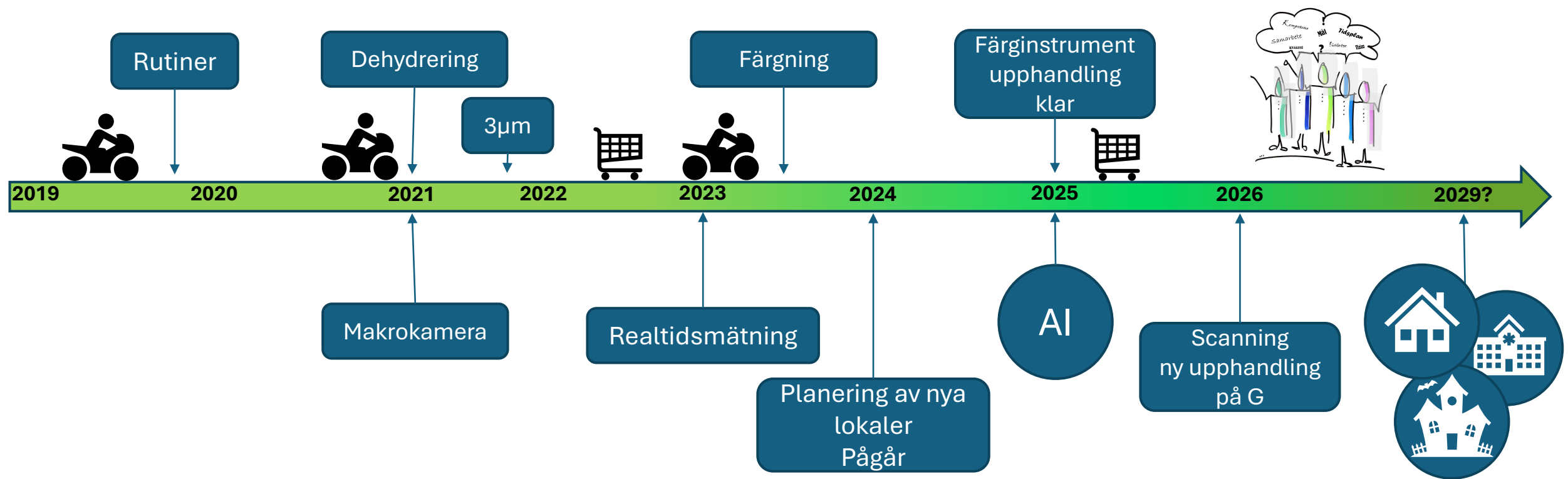
